



Scholarship Policy

Requests for scholarships are accepted from any family who wants to participate in The Edge Performance Academy teaching sessions and/or camp programs but who is experience financial difficulties.

Scholarships awarded may be applied toward tuition for class and summer camp sessions. Applicants must be willing to submit financial information in order to be considered for a scholarship award.

Scholarships are not awarded to cover costs of production-related fees or production t-shirts, make-up kits, or costume items.

Scholarships can assist the recipient family in paying for registration tuition up to the full cost of tuition. Families can obtain a Tuition Scholarship Application on the Performance Academy website (www.theeproject.org). **Forms must be submitted prior to the first day of class or camp.** Late scholarship applications cannot be considered.

Submitted applications will be confidentially forwarded to the Executive Director upon submission. The application will be evaluated and processed for immediate consideration. Once an approval response has been received, the applicants will be notified via a written letter from the Executive Director or his/her designee.

All scholarship information is confidentially maintained and is not disclosed or discussed with any other Performance Academy personnel.

Scholarship requests will not be considered after the first scheduled class or camp meeting has occurred.

Account balances will not be carried over from one session to the next. If account balances have not been paid in full by the end of the current session, the student will be ineligible for subsequent sessions until such time that all account balances have been settled.

Scholarship awards are non-transferrable. This policy is subject to change at any time.
